VOLUNTEERS MUST COMPLETE THE WAIVER AND RELEASE FORM ANNUALLY.

WILDLANDS RESTORATION VOLUNTEERS (WRV) is a nonprofit organization with a mission to foster a community spirit of shared responsibility for the stewardship and restoration of public, protected, and ecologically significant lands across Colorado and beyond. WRV furthers its charitable mission through volunteers who make very significant contributions to the restoration of wild places. In turn, WRV is committed to providing opportunities for our volunteers to acquire technical skills, develop leadership skills, spend time in inspiring places, enjoy delicious and nourishing food, engage in meaningful work, make connections with others, and have fun! We are pleased to welcome you to the WRV community.

In connection with your volunteer participation, there are certain terms and conditions with which you are expected to comply. This Volunteer Waiver and Release Agreement sets forth the applicable expectations, rules, regulations, and terms of your participation.

VOLUNTARY PARTICIPATION. I am voluntarily participating as a WRV Volunteer engaged in various forms of land restoration activities and all related activities incidental to such participation (“Volunteer Activities”). As such, I understand that I am not an agent or employee of WRV for any purpose and am not entitled to receive compensation or any other employment-related benefits such as worker’s compensation. During the entire term of my volunteer participation, I shall be solely responsible for my own medical, disability, hazard and liability insurance coverage. _____ (initial)

PARTNERS. WRV Volunteer Activities involve various partner organizations and landowners (“Partners”). This Agreement extends to WRV’s Partners (listed in Attachment 1).

TYPES OF ACTIVITIES. WRV Volunteer Activities range from evening native seed collections, full-day events involving sawyers running chainsaws, overnight trail-building events, multi-day alpine habitat restoration, youth-centered activities, and much more. Each Volunteer Activity involves a unique set of potential hazards described below.

Prior to registering for a WRV Volunteer Activity, I agree to familiarize myself with the likely risks and hazards of that Volunteer Activity and carefully evaluate my ability to safely participate given those challenges. I am aware that WRV provides “ratings” for most Volunteer Activities to assist volunteers in identifying appropriate Volunteer Activities. Ratings contain general information on difficulty, travel distances and other details. I assume full responsibility for selecting projects/programs based upon this or other information, and my mental, physical and emotional preparedness to participate. _____ (initial)

HAZARDS AND RISKS. I understand that WRV Volunteer Activities involve various land restoration, and associated, activities in sometimes remote outdoor settings, and that there are many potential risks involved in these Volunteer Activities.

I understand that there is an inherent risk of personal injury and even death associated with my participation in WRV Volunteer Activities. I recognize that each Volunteer Activity involves a unique set of potential hazards to which I may be exposed, including, but not limited to: riding in vehicles over unimproved and uneven roads; exposure to remote outdoor environments; extreme weather/climate conditions; sites that may be wet, slippery, steep and/or uneven; tasks requiring significant physical exertion; malfunctioning or misused tools and equipment; encounters with insects and wildlife; working closely with other volunteers; lack of access to medical facilities or personnel; use of outdoor cooking and camping equipment; mental, physical and emotional health and participation risks; other natural and man-made hazards, and more.

SUPERVISION. I understand that I will be asked to perform the activities and duties assigned to me under the supervision of a designated WRV employee, volunteer leader or Partner. I agree to pay close attention to all the directions given to me. I understand that if I present a safety concern or medical risk,

am disruptive, or otherwise conduct myself in a detrimental manner, that I may be dismissed from volunteer service at any time. If I am dismissed or depart from a Volunteer Activity for any reason, I agree to be responsible for all costs of early departure, including medical evacuation, or treatment. _____ (initial)

USE OF WRV TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT. During my participation in WRV Volunteer Activities, I will have access to WRV-owned tools and equipment. I understand that any such tools and equipment are to be used solely for activities directly related to the Volunteer Activity. I agree that I will pay close attention to the instructions for their proper use and operation, as well as the risks associated with the use of any equipment or tools, and that I will operate such tools properly and safely. If I am not comfortable with the tools and equipment, I agree to notify a WRV representative to ask for help or will decline to use them. _____ (initial)

HEALTH / MEDICAL ISSUES. I assert that I am in good health and am not aware of any physical or mental condition that might endanger me or others during my participation in Volunteer Activities. I agree to bring appropriate first aid supplies and medications I may need, including those to counteract potentially serious allergic reaction (for example, anaphylaxis resulting from allergy to bee stings), and to notify WRV of any special medications I may need. I also authorize WRV and Partners, representatives and/or associated medical personnel to obtain or provide medical care for me, to transport me to a medical facility and to provide treatment they consider necessary for my health; I agree to pay all associated costs.

I agree to take appropriate steps to ensure my personal health and endurance during the Volunteer Activities, including rest, food, water, and carrying any needed medications. I acknowledge that WRV makes no warranty or representation, expressed or implied, regarding the conditions that may be encountered during my participation in the Volunteer Activities. _____ (initial)

TRANSPORTATION. If I use my own vehicle to transport myself and others to locations where Volunteer Activities will take place, I agree to possess a valid driver's license and to use only a duly registered and insured vehicle. Any accident that occurs while I am driving my own vehicle is my sole liability. Prior to driving a WRV-owned or hired vehicle, I agree to possess a valid driver's license and to release a copy of my Department of Motor Vehicles record to WRV. _____ (initial)

PHOTO RELEASE. I authorize WRV and Partners to use my likeness in photograph(s) or video, written or spoken statements in any and all of its publications and in any and all other media, including public website publication and social media channels, whether now known or hereafter existing, controlled by WRV or its Partners in perpetuity. _____ (initial)

ASSUMPTION OF RISK / AGREEMENT TO RELEASE. I agree that I am voluntarily participating in the Volunteer Activities with knowledge of the dangers involved and hereby assume sole responsibility for all such risks and hazards.

I agree not to hold WRV or its Partners liable or responsible for my injury or death, or for any damage to any of my property in connection with any and all costs, damages, losses, claims, causes of action, and liabilities (herein "Losses") which I may suffer in connection with my participation in the Volunteer Activities described herein, including any travel before, during, or after the activities. This assumption of

risk includes Losses caused by the ordinary negligence (whether active or passive) of WRV and Partners, but excludes Losses caused by gross negligence or more culpable conduct of WRV and Partners.

I understand and agree that I am releasing WRV and Partners, and their predecessors, successors, assigns, affiliates, subsidiaries and parent companies from the consequences of their negligence, even if that negligence causes personal injury, death or property damage.

I understand that this document disqualifies me from recovering damages against WRV should I be injured in the course of my voluntary participation in Volunteer Activities. I shall defend and hold harmless WRV, its board, employees, agents, Partners, and other volunteers from and against all claims, accusations, notices, judgments, rulings, liabilities, or expenses that may exist as a result of my participation.

This agreement is legally enforceable and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of Colorado in the United States of America. Any portion of this Document deemed unlawful or unenforceable shall not affect the remaining provisions. I will attempt to settle any dispute (that cannot be settled by discussion) through mediation before a mutually acceptable Colorado mediator. _____
